





Grades VI, VII, and VIII constitute the Middle Stage, where students transition from the preteen years of the Primary Section to the beginning of the Upper Primary Section. This phase marks a significant period of physical, mental and social development, with students gaining independence and confidence in balancing their studies and co-curricular activities. The curriculum remains consistent across these grades, encompassing subjects such as Mathematics, Science, Social Science, General Knowledge, and Artificial Intelligence. Besides these, students are exposed to two mandatory languages: English and Hindi, while being allowed to make a choice between Gujarati or Sanskrit, a third language.

An additional and exciting feature introduced by the CBSE Board is Skill Education. A variety of Skill Modules e.g. Design Thinking, Data Science, Handicraft, Travel and Tourism, Mass Communication, Herbal Heritage, Financial Literacy etc. have been shortlisted by our institution to develop in students a readiness for understanding and appreciating practical and manual skills and their application in their lives.

Another important highlight of our educational approach is the incorporation of S.T.E.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math), which engages students in hands-on learning experiences, leading to notable achievements. Co-curricular activities, including Physical Education, Library Science, Performing Arts (Dance and Music- both Vocal and Instrumental), and Creative Art and Craft, are also integral parts of our program, fostering creativity and innovation among students.

At Navrachana Vidyani, we emphasize on problem solving, reasoning, rational and critical thinking rather than rote learning in our students. This is imparted through the discussion of H.O.T.S. (Higher Order Thinking Skills) questions, regular training in the preparation of Competitive examinations and continuous deliberations of the world around us (General Knowledge).

Soft Skills, being the need of the hour, are instilled in our students through organizing school events that demand multitasking through systematic planning skills, time management, discipline and dealing with guests. Thus, this section of the school sees students take on some important positions in the Student Council body too.

Overall, the Middle Stage form the cornerstone of the school which entails the holistic development of its students thereby transforming them into enlightened human beings.
